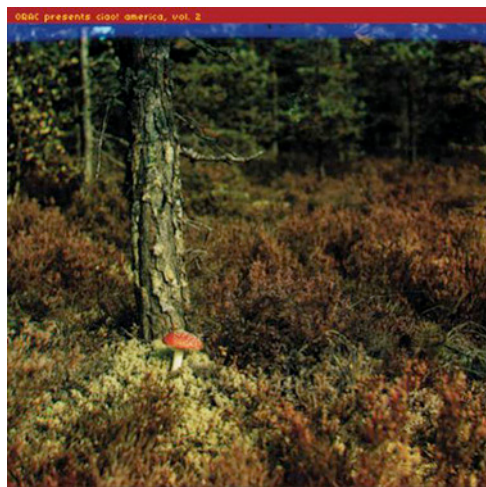

With this second volume of their debut compilation "Ciao! America," Orac paints a fuller picture of the territory outlined in volume one. More involved electronic excursions come to light, and above all the label's stalwart love of techno, electro, and experimentation is made clear.

Ben Nevile brings you ORACattaxx, a danceable late-night TV commercial for a brand-new shadow government.

War Dialer brings some solid electro to the table which owes equally to the Detroit masters of the genre and to the history of remote system cracking from 1984-present.

Caro takes a moment from his musings in his crystal castle to broadcast the mysterious sounds floating around in there.

Lexaunculpt has given us a brief burst of intense nostalgia processed through modern digital apparatus.

Finally, B Phenix drives us out into the sunset with "tomorrow lost yesterday", following up on the nostalgia tip, but conveying us into a spacious future with room for possibilities.
