*Super Contact Danse* was conceived early one morning in Montreal as Caro walked back from a show with a group of good friends. He saw a neon sign and starting singing *Super*, and the friends started singing *Contact Danse* back, and the need to capture the moment became clear. A glossy vocal intro worthy of His Purpleness starts the track off, and then bruising kick drums, ghetto house basslines, and a sultry whispered/vocoded call and response take care of business.

Ben Nevile brings the remix like last time. We think we see the makings of an inseparable production and remix partnership like Inner City and Magic Juan here. Ben's rework takes *Super Contact Danse* down a dark alley the original was afraid to go into. And just as things are getting really sketchy, a warm acoustic guitar solo comes in to save the day.

On the flip is *See You Shining*, a ten-minute tech-house story with a strong Latin flavor. The story comes from an experience in which Caro was caught between the dream and the real. It is personal and musical—the shimmering sounds and strange, submerged vocals are Caro's best effort yet to take you to that other place and keep you there, dancing.
