<p>This is the long-awaited sequel to <i>Unclassified Computer Funk</i>, the record that kicked off Orac's Black+White series, and got discerning retailer Smallfish to gush "Absolutely, positively, undoubtedly one of the most rockingest, sickest, illest tracks of the year so far!" Dave Segal noted that "The prankster spirit of Spike Jones, Jean-Jacques Perry and Akufen animates these four gems," and we couldn't agree more.</p> <p>Since the first <i>Unclassified Computer Funk</i>, both artists have been busy guys. Paradroid has put out new records on Force Inc. and Adjunct, and [a]pendics has been touring widely as well as releasing on labels including Friends of Tomorrow and Mo's Ferry since the release of his album <i>Helicopter Hearts</i> on Orac.</p> <p>On <i>Unclassified Computer Funk 2</i>, Paradroid and [a]pendics.shuffle trade samples remix style, so the result sounds more unified, more collaborative than last time. It's animated by the same prankster spirit but more expansive, with more dark and cinematic spaces bursting out from cracks in the manic beats. Somehow this evokes the range of feels we associate with soundtrack music, from nostalgia to paranoia to dark humor, yet remains totally danceable. Quite a feat.</p>
